
Below are the instructions for accessing the public view of a district's Federal Programs/ESEA Consolidated Application, which includes their budgets and plans for spending in Title I.A, Title III-Immigrant, Title III-English Learner, Title IV.A, and Title V.B. A similar path can be used to access other publicly available information about any Missouri school district.


1. Go to the main Department of Elementary and Secondary Education website: https://dese.mo.gov/



2. Choose the Web Applications tab toward the middle of the home screen:



On the DESE Secured Web Application Logon screen, click the button View Public Applications:



From the User Applications Menu, choose ePeGS




5. Choose the public school district you wish to view by entering their county-district code. If you do not know the county-district code, you can change the search method by clicking the radio button above the dropdown box entitled "Name" rather than "Code." You can then begin typing the district's official name into the box, and can use the dropdown menu to choose the correct district. After the district has been chosen, hit the Select button.



6. Choose the Funding Application Menu button, or the Funding Application Menu option from the left navigation menu.




7. From the Funding Application Menu screen, Expand the Quality Schools bar by hitting "Show." Choose ESEA Consolidated from the submenu.




8. From the ESEA Consolidated Grant Summary screen, expand the Budget Application bar by hitting "Show." Choose the most recently approved version of the application. In this case, there is only one, and it can be accessed by clicking "Initial." If a district revises a budget, there could be multiple iterations labeled "Revision 1," "Revision 2," and so on. For up-to-date information, choose the one with the most recent approval date.



9. From the Funds Available screen, you can get a snapshot of the different programs for which the district receives ESEA funding, and how much they have available for the current year. You can also access the complete menu from the lefthand navigation column. All areas that have a filled-in black triangle can be clicked and expanded to show submenus. From these menus, any available program's approved budget grid and descriptive plan for how they will spend the funds can be accessed, along with any comments from the district or DESE.



10. If you click on the ESEA Consolidated Plan in the lefthand navigation, it will expand to show the different parts of the plan, including the School Level Plan. If you expand that "School Level" line further, each Title I.A-served school will appear. Click on the building with the plan you would like to view.



11. Once you choose the building, a screen will come up that has the School, Parent, and Family Engagement Policy, the Comprehensive Needs Assessment, and the

Schoolwide Program. If you click the "Show" link, the Schoolwide Program will expand. You can then view the entirety of the plan.
